Program: Jason Beck, from Wilcox Nursery presented a program on landscaping with native plants (arranged by Kyle Pierson). Members contributed finger food and the church supplied coffee. Greg Crane arranged for a projector and computer for the presentation. Jason brought a large variety of plants to show and sell. He also showed a PowerPoint presentation demonstrating before and after landscape designs. He talked about how to choose trees, shrubs and ground cover for use in bright sun areas and deep shade areas. He talked about drought-tolerant plants and the growing habits of plants and grasses in different environments. He spoke at length -- 90 minutes. The members asked questions and some purchased plants.

New Business:

1. A motion was made to pay Jason an honorarium of \$75.00 for his presentation. Motion seconded and passed. Kay wrote the check and delivered it to Jason before he left.

2. A motion was made to pay the church a donation of \$50.00 each time we use their hall. Motion seconded and passed.
3. Linda Sample will organize the program next month, Feb. 20th.

4. Green Fest plants will be purchased from Dan Hansen's and Jeff Johnson's Daylily Garden. Gayle will ask Jeff what he can supply so he can reserve plants for us now. Linda Sample motioned we budget \$300.00 and Sue Simmons seconded, the motion passed.
5. A discussion about including a "proper planting of daylilies" teachable moment in the Green Fest booth occurred. Members agreed this would be beneficial and interesting for customers. Gayle has an idea for increasing knowledge about the many varieties of daylilies grown for sale. She would like members to donate old daylily catalogues to her and she will make and affix a sticker with BADS information to each catalogue and distribute them at the show. She has put out a call for members to bring their unwanted catalogues to the next meeting.
6. Most members have not yet responded to the call to send photos of their daylily gardens to Kyle Pierson who volunteered to create a movie presentation for the March 20th meeting. Greg Crane (FBC) requested an email in advance of the meeting as he must reserve the room and technology for that day.
7. A motion was made and seconded that a photo competition be added as part of the BADS Spring Show. The public would be invited to cast ballots for their favorite picture. The pictures would win according to the most votes. The motion was passed. The addition of this would allow the public to have some participation in the show while the flower judging takes place and closed to the public.
8. Gayle Nipper volunteered to create the BADS show schedule. This schedule must be made in advance and approved by AHS if our show is to be within AHS official rules.
9. A motion was made to waive BADS dues for current and renewing (for the current year) AHS members. Motion was seconded and passed.
