Jay Jarman called the meeting to order at 10:10. Minutes from the September meeting were passed around to members. No changes were made.

Kay Smith gave the treasure's report: Balance:  
Past month revenues: \$5 from Judi Mortensen's dues and \$24 from markers  
Past month expenditures: \$50 use of the church

Jay reported on the internet survey results in which 20 people participated.

1. Kay reported that the club paid the Fall Regional fee for Greg Crane and Gayle Nipper.
2. 6 BADS members attended.
3. Greg told us that Tim Bell was the speaker and brought plants for the plant auction. He also reported that we are locked into our usual date for our Show and Sale of the first Saturday in May. May is a very busy month with the Spring Regional- May20-21, 2011 and AHS National Convention-May 27-29, 2011. Two other Region 12 clubs have their Show and Sale on the second Saturday in May.
