1. Greenfest – Kay Smith reported that the 2009 budget for Greenfest was \$612.00. The 2009 budget for BADS Show was \$1,500. Jay Jarman moved that we reverse the order of spending, thus spend \$1,500 to purchase plants for Greenfest since this is our biggest selling event. We will plan to spend \$600.00 for plants for BADS show this year. Jay and Jeff have extra plants growing in their yards (about 4 varieties) that could be sold. Further, it was suggested that we consider buying plants [from Jerome and Reba Ridaught's farm](#) in Alachua. They average about \$2.00 per plant. The motion was seconded and passed.
2. Greenfest – Dennis will be having knee surgery the same week that Greenfest is scheduled. He usually takes responsibility for getting our booth set up tables, information posters, etc. out of storage and he then loads his truck and transports it over to the University of Tampa site for the event. Greg Crane and Jay Jarman volunteered to do this this year.
3. . Greenfest Chairperson Gayle Nipper requests members send any un-wanted catalogues to her so she can use them as advertising to promote BADS membership at Greenfest.

4. Dan Trimmer, owner of Watermill Gardens, will present the program for our Feb. 19 meeting. Dan will bring plants to sell. He has agreed to a 50 percent split with the club. We would like as much publicity for this event as possible. Kyle will contact the *St. Petersburg Times* to include this in their Garden Calendar. (Note: at the time the program was announced, the deadline for getting events listed in the calendar had passed. The *St. Pete Times* has moved up their deadline to a month lead before the event.) Linda Sample will contact the garden writer for the Tampa Tribune.
5. Kay Smith would like to us to initiate an “outreach” program. She suggests that our active members call inactive members and invite them to the next meeting with Dan Trimmer.
6. Linda Sample encouraged members to plan to attend the [National Show to be held in Baton Rouge, Louisiana](#). May 25- 28. The area is a great vacation destination with world famous cuisine, culture and music – not to mention daylilies. Sign up now. There is a 700-person limit for the bus tour of gardens.
